


- Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. (2 Peter 3:13)

Revelation 21

- > new heaven and a new earth (v. 1)
- the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (v. 2)
- Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself shall be with them, and be their God. (v. 3)
- And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. (v. 4 / Isaiah 25:8)
- make all things new (v. 5)
- drink of the water of life freely. (v. 6)
- inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. (v. 7)

Affliction shall not rise up a second time (Nahum 1:9)

new Jerusalem city (Revelation 21 cont'd)

- great walls, gates, precious stones [jewels] and pearls (vs. 10-20)
- streets of pure gold, as it were transparent glass. (v. 21)
- > no need for sunlight or moonlight: God did lighten [the city] and the Lamb is the light (v. 23)

Revelation 22

- pure river of water of life (v. 1)
- the tree of life, twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month, leaves for healing (v. 2)
- no more curse (v. 3)
- they [we] shall see His face; and His name shall be in their foreheads (v. 4)
- no night; the Lord giveth them light, and they [we] shall reign for ever and ever (v. 5)



"To him that overcometh will I give":

- eat of tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God. (Rev. 2:7)
- eat of hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written (Rev. 2:17)
- power over the nations....And I will give him the morning star. (Rev. 2:26,28)
- clothed in white raiment... I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. (Rev. 3:5)
- grant to sit with me in my throne (Rev. 3:21)

Treasures in Heaven

- To not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matthew 6:19-21)
